Prohibited conduct or activities by beer permit holders.

It shall be unlawful for any beer permit holder to:

Make or allow any sale *or distribution* of beer between the hours of 12:00 midnight and 6 a.m. from Sunday to Friday and *between 1:00 a.m. and* 12:00 noon on Sunday.

Serve, sell, or allow the consumption on his premises of any alcoholic beverage with an alcoholic content of more than *eight percent (8%)* by weight *unless otherwise authorized by state law.*

(1) The beer board is authorized to issue a special occasion beer permit to bona fide charitable or nonprofit organizations for sale of beer for on-premises consumption at special events.

(2) The special occasion beer permit shall not be issued for longer than one (1) forty-eight-hour period, unless otherwise specified by the beer board, subject to the limitations on the hours, imposed by law.

(3) The application for the special occasion beer permit shall state whether the applicant is a charitable or nonprofit organization, include documents showing evidence of the type of organization, and state the location of the premises upon which beer shall be served and the purpose for the request of the permit.

(4) For purposes of this section, bona fide charitable or nonprofit organization means any corporation or other legal entity which has been recognized as exempt from federal taxes under section 501(c) of the Internal Revenue Code.

(5) No charitable or nonprofit organization possessing a special occasion beer permit shall obtain beer for sale or distribution from any source other than a valid permit holder or any other source authorized by state law.

(6) Special Occasion Permits shall not be valid for events at Town-owned facilities unless approved by both the Beer Board prior to the Special Occasion.

Special Event Application fee: A non-refundable \$100.00 fee must accompany this application for a Special Occasion Beer Permit.
