CONDITIONS OF BEER PERMITS

Permits shall be issued to the owner of the business, whether a person, firm, corporation, jointstock company, syndicate, or association.

A permit is only for a single location.

A permit is valid only for the business of the owner named in the permit.

A permit holder shall return a permit to the Town of Walden within (15) days of termination of the business, change in ownership, relocation of the business or change of the business name. A change in ownership occurs for a corporate owner when at lease (50%) of the stock of the corporation is transferred to a new owner.

No container of beer shall be sold to any patron except in connection with a meal ordered by such patron for consumption on the premises.

No more than three (3) twelve (12) ounce containers of beer shall be sold to any patron on any day for consumption on premises.

Gross sales receipts derived for the sale of beer on the premises by the holder of this permit shall not exceed (50%) of the total revenue derived in any calendar year from the operation of the restaurant facilities on the premises, including gross receipts derived from the sale of beer. Permit holder will provide, upon request, documentation to support compliance with this condition.

It shall be unlawful for any beer permit holder to:

- 1. Employ any person convicted for possession, sale, manufacture, or transportation of intoxicating liquor, or any crime involving moral turpitude within the pas (10) years.
- 2. Employ any minor less than twenty-one (21) years of age in sale, storage, distribution, or manufacture of beer.
- 3. Make or allow any sale of beer between the hours of 12:00 midnight and 6 a.m. during any day of the week and at any time before 12:00 (noon) on Sunday.
- 4. Allow any loud, unusual, or obnoxious noises to emanate from his premises.
- 5. Make or allow any sale of beer to a minor less than twenty-one (21) years of age.

- 6. Make or allow any sale of beer to any intoxicated person or to any feeble-minded, insane, or otherwise mentally incapacitated person.
- 7. Allow drunk or disreputable persons to loiter about these premises.
- 8. Serve, sell, or allow the consumption on his premises of any alcoholic beverage with an alcoholic content of more than five percent (5%) by weight.

I am knowledgeable of the laws prohibiting the sale of beer to minors. I hereby certify that no person having at least a 5% ownership interest, nor any person to be employed in the distribution or sale of beer in my establishment, has been convicted of any violation of the beer or alcoholic beverage laws or any crime involving moral turpitude within the past ten years. I am also aware that I shall not be issued a permit, or my permit shall be revoked, if my business location causes traffic congestion or interferes with schools, churches or other places of public gathering, or otherwise interferes with public health, safety and morals. I further attest that no sales will be made to minors.

NOTICE: A non-refundable \$250.00 fee must accompany this application. If the application is approved, you are required to provide documentation of sales tax registration to the city within ten days of approval. Any applicant making false statement in this application shall forfeit his/her permit and shall not be eligible to receive any permit for a period of ten years.

A privilege tax of \$100.00 is imposed on the business of selling, distributing, storing or manufacturing beer in this state effective January 1, 1994, and each successive January 1. Any holder of a beer permit issued after January 1 shall pay a pro rata portion of this annual tax when the permit is issued.
